The Green Product Award 2020 Green Product Award & Green Concept Award 2020: Record number of participants with submissions from 52 countries The winners have been determined - the first vegan leather alternative made of cactus, a zero-emission house, a golden dress made of algae, a road surface made of solar panels, and much more.

Berlin, 13. 03. 2020 - The winners of the Green Product Award and the Green Concept Award have been announced. With a record number of 1463 submissions, more participants than ever before have applied. In total, the ideas and products, concepts and materials for creating a more sustainable future come from 6 continents.

Insights into the green future

What does a green future look like and what fits into "Future Village" (award theme)? Winners and nominees will give examples from the categories of architecture, bathroom, electronics, fashion, children, consumer goods, mobility, outdoor, office and interior.
