



3D printed Sunglasses & Cork-Concrete Blend win Green Product Traders Award

Stockholm/Berlin, 16.02.2016 – A selection of submissions to the 2016 Green Product Award was shown at Scandinavia's biggest design fair last week - trade visitors awarded the best entry with the „Green Product Traders Award“

Over the course of five days trade visitors of the **Stockholm Furniture & Light Fair** could have a first look at selected entries to this year's Green Product Awards.

25 products were exhibited, that displayed a wide range of sustainable and innovative product designs, ranging from high heels manufactured with special fabric made of fungus, glasses made entirely out of wood, longboards created from „upcycled“ materials, to mobile solar panels.

Due to an equal number of votes cast by the trade visitors, eventually two prizes were handed out: **Lea Huch** from **PROJEKT SAMSEN** Berlin as well as **Nina Ruthe-Kein** und **David Antonin** of **Designstudio NIRUK** from Hürth, Germany both were awarded with the Green Product Traders Award 2016.

Lea Huch designed ultra-light, virtually unbreakable Sunglasses that are not only highly fashionable accessories but are also produced using resource conserving 3D-print technology.

Just as Projekt Samsen, **Studio NIRUK's** designers also succeeded in combining innovation and aesthetics: With their blend of recycled cork and concrete named **„Corcrete“** they created a completely new material that is both visually and technologically appealing.
